Why wasn't the woman allowed to go further?

Discussion: Pria pada percakapan mengatakan 'I can't let you go beyond this point without a boarding pass.' Kata 'boarding pass' inilah yang menjadi kata kunci. Si wanita tidak diizinkan masuk lebih jauh ke area bandara karena dia tidak memiliki *boarding pass* (kartu tanda penumpang).

Jawaban: C

11. Man : Congratulations. I heard that you've got a scholarship.

Woman : Thank you very much.

Man : I know that you can make it.

What does the man comment on?

Discussion: Pernyataan pria dalam percakapan tersebut yang menyatakan 'Congratulations. I heard that you've got a scholarship' (Selamat. Saya dengar kamu mendapatkan beasiswa.) merupakan bentuk suatu pujian, yaitu pujian atas pencapaian suatu prestasi yang dibuktikan dengan diperolehnya beasiswa.

Jawaban: C

12. Discussion: dari dialog disebutkan cara untuk membuat makanan pencuci mulut.

Jawaban: D

13. Discussion: Dari dialog di sebutkan *steaming the mixture*.

Jawaban: B

14. Discussion: Pengumuman tersebut dibuat dengan tujuan untuk menginformasikan kepada para pebelanja bahwa telah ditemukan sebuah dompet di blok bagian perlangkapan wanita.

Jawaban: D

15. Discussion: tempat yang baik untuk komplain adalah *customer service counter*.

Jawaban: B

READING SECTION

16. Discussion: pada soal di atas termasuk *invitation expression*. Kata *would* biasa dipakai dalam *invitation*/mengundang. Dan bentuk *invitation* yang sopan dan benar selalu memakai *would you like*.

Jawaban: C

17. Discussion: pada kalimat yang rumpang diisi permintaan bantuan dan jawaban D adalah permintaan yang biasa dipakai dalam percakapan telekomunikasi untuk berbicara atau disambungkan dengan seseorang.

Jawaban: D

18. Discussion: Dari pilihan jawaban yang merujuk pada deskripsi mobil adalah "Mobil biru buatan Jepang dengan dua pintu" dan mobil dua pintu paling masuk akal dari pada *a wheel* (satu roda) atau *storey* (tingkat).

Jawaban: D

19. Discussion: Pilihan A menjawab pertanyaan direktur yang menanyakan tentang persiapan ulang tahun bulan depan.

Jawaban: A

20. Melihat jawaban dari Ina, yaitu menunjukkan arah, berarti menanyakan arah menuju terminal bus.

Jawaban: D

21. Dari ke empat pilihan yang sesuai untuk mendeskripsikan benda adalah pilihan C.

Jawaban: C

22. Discussion: termasuk dalam "Prohibition Sentence" Leni meminta untuk tidak gaduh. Jadi, jawaban yang tepat (*The students are having an examination*), yaitu siswa sedang mengerjakan ujian.

Jawaban: D

23. Discussion: dari pertanyaan di atas jawaban yang sesuai menggunakan kalimat "conditional sentence type 3 (if + s + had + v3, S + Would + have + v3)" dan jawaban C lebih masuk akal karena

maksudnya Joanna pasti akan datang jika Carol memberikan undanganya atau memberitahunya, tetapi kenyataanya tidak demikian.

Jawaban: C

24. Discussion: Pola kalimat di atas adalah memberikan nasihat (advice) atas mobil yang rusak. Sehingga jawaban yang benar adalah D yang artinya Tuan Budi disarankan untuk mengecekkan mobilnya.

Jawaban: D

25. Discussion: Jawaban yang tepat untuk melengkapi dialog di atas adalah B karena ada pertanyaan 'how much' yang dipakai untuk menanyakan harga sesuatu. Dalam jawaban B ada kata *fee* yang artinya ongkos atau biaya.

Jawaban: B

26. Discussion: Dari kalimat di atas yang tidak betul penggunaan katanya terletak pada kata *am* harusnya diganti *do* karena ada *hear* (V1). Kalau menggunakan 'am', maka kata 'hear' menjadi 'hearing'.

Jawaban: B

27. Discussion: Kalimat yang tepat seharusnya menggunakan *have not to* jika kata *not* ada di depan *have*, maka harus ada kata *do*, jadi jawabannya bisa juga 'do not have to'.

Jawaban: C

28. Discussion: kalimat yang tepat untuk mengganti adalah *that a student*, karena *a student* adalah subjek dan is predikat, predikat tidak bisa mendahului subjek kecuali dalam kalimat tanya.

Jawaban: A

29. Discussion: pada pilihan 'A' terdapat dua modal yang tidak benar. Kalimat di atas cukup menggunakan *was* saja dan kata *be* tidak perlu digunakan. Bentuk kalimat pasif (subject + to be + V3).

Jawaban: A

30. Discussion: Frasa yang tepat adalah "*help me to*" karena di awal ada modal *could* yang harus diikuti

V1 tanpa *to*.

Jawaban: C

31. Discussion: Termasuk dalam "comparative degree" sehingga *phrase* yang tepat untuk menggantikan *most conventional* adalah *more conventional*. Kata kuncinya ada pada kata 'than' kata tersebut selalu berkaitan dengan kata *more* yang muncul terlebih dahulu (*more ...than...*).

Jawaban: D

32. Discussion: Jenis kalimat di atas merupakan bentuk *feeling expression*. Kalimat yang betul adalah *confused* bukan *confusing* karena beda bentuk beda arti. *Confusing* artinya membingungkan dan *confused* artinya bingung.

Jawaban: D

33. Discussion: Kalimat tersebut belum lengkap karena tidak ada subjek dan *to be*-nya. Seharusnya 'Are you going home'. *To be* diletakkan di awal kalimat karena kalimat tanya.

Jawaban: A

- 34 Discussion: "is" tidak tepat digunakan dalam kalimat itu seharusnya "are" karena menunjukkan benda jamak. Bentuk jamak ditunjukkan oleh 's' yang ada pada kata 'eggs'.

Jawaban: B

35. Discussion: *Should* tidak tepat untuk menanyakan pilihan seharusnya "should" dan 'would' digunakan untuk menanyakan pilihan yang sopan.

Jawaban: C

36. Discussion: Pertanyaan soal ini menanyakan alasan Mr. Krick menulis surat. Tentu saja jawabannya; Mr. Krick akan melamar pekerjaan yang simpulkan dari kalimat kedua.

Jawaban: A

37. Discussion: Dari surat di atas tertulis 'an article in the New and Observer' yang maksudnya sebuah artikel yang ada di koran dan tidak ada artikel di radio atau TV.

Jawaban: C

38. Discussion: Dalam perusahaan biasanya pelamar sebelum bekerja di-*interview* terlebih dahulu atau setelah memasukkan surat lamaran.

Jawaban: D

39. Discussion: persamaan kata dari “fresh” adalah “new”.

Jawaban: B

40. Discussion: Dari daftar peraturan diatas bisa disimpulkan bahwa *notice* tersebut adalah sebuah peraturan di perpustakaan.

Jawaban: B

41. Discussion: Dari daftar (peraturan nomor 4) di atas disebutkan boleh meminjam sampai empat buku. Jadi, yang paling sesuai adalah jawaban D (lebih dari 2).

Jawaban: D

42. Discussion: Ingat ada kata *except* yang artinya kecuali. Dari daftar di atas yang tidak boleh adalah makan dan minum (peraturan nomor 1).

Jawaban: A

43. Discussion: “Personal” adalah perseorangan jadi lawan dari personal adalah “public” (umum atau orang banyak).

Jawaban: B

44. Discussion: Dari isi dari pengumuman di atas adalah informasi orang hilang. Kata kuncinya ada pada kalimat “disappeared” pada kalimat pertama, yang artinya menghilang dan bersinonim dengan kata “missing”.

Jawaban: A

45. Discussion: Di teks disebutkan tinggi badan 165 cm dan berat 100. Ini menunjukkan tidak ideal antara tinggi badan dan berat badan yang artinya kegemukan (*overweight*).
